Alexander the Great The "notable horn" from Greece



- Tutored by Aristotle
- Began ruling at 20
- Brutal, Bloody King
 - Full Conqueror at 26
- Died in Babylon at 32

Alexander Mosaic, Pompeii, c. 100 BC Seen fighting Darius III in 333 BC 200 years after Daniel's vision

¹⁵ When I, Daniel, had seen the vision, I sought to understand it. ... "Gabriel, make this man understand the vision." ¹⁷ So he came near where I stood. LIMITED Powerful Authority

Omnipotent, Omniscient, Omnipresent

^{25b} and he shall be broken—but by no human hand.

OVERTHROWN Powerful Authority

Hebrews 2:14-15
