Rebuilding with Purpose

Ezra 9:9 For we are slaves. Yet our God has not forsaken us in our slavery...to grant us some reviving...to repair its ruins Rebuilding with Spirt & Truth

Ezra 3:2 ...and they built the altar of the God of Israel

Nehemiah 8:8, 12 They read from the book, from the Law of God...so that the people understood the reading.

Rebuilding with Prayer

Nehemiah 1:5 And I said, "O LORD God of heaven, the great and awesome God who keeps covenant and steadfast love ...hear the prayer of your servant

Rebuilding in Community

Nehemiah 4:16 From that day on, half of my servants worked on construction, and half held the spears,

Rebuilding in Opposition

Nehemiah 4:18 And each of the builders had his sword strapped at his side while he built. The man who sounded the trumpet was beside me.

Rebuilding in God's Strength

Haggai 2 ^{5b} My Spirit remains in your midst. Fear not. ⁶ For thus says the Lord of hosts: Yet once more, in a little while, I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land.

Rebuilding through Sacrifice

Haggai 1 ⁷ "Thus says the LORD of hosts: Consider your ways. ⁸ Go up to the hills and bring wood and build the house, that I may take pleasure in it and that I may be glorified, says the LORD.

Quoted in Acts 2 referring to Pentecost

Acts 2

²² "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know—²³ this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.
²⁴ God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.

John 2

¹⁹ Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will *raise it up*." ²⁰ The Jews then said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?" ²¹ But he was speaking about the temple of his body. ²² When therefore he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the Scripture and the word that Jesus had spoken. "For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

> For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."
