

## Galatians 1:10-24

For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

<sup>11</sup> For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. <sup>12</sup> For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ. <sup>13</sup> For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it.

## **Our Pursuit of Value**

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My behavior determines my value and my status before God

• Job; Experience; Accomplishments; "likes"; "views"

Relationships - spouse, kids, name drops

Appearance - social media or in person

• Preferences - music, media, hobbies, coffee...

• Beliefs - political, social, theological

How are you impacted when criticized? Flattered? What devastates you...or elevates you?

## God's Gift of Value

<sup>15</sup> But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, <sup>16a</sup> was pleased to reveal his Son to me,

Matthew 3:16-17 <sup>16</sup> And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; 17 and behold, a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Jesus' behavior determines my value.

## Living a Life of Value

Jesus' behavior determines my Value; My Value determines my Behavior

- 1) Worship: Focus is on God and His Glory (rather than me and mine)
  - 2) Generosity: Give myself away rather than demand from God and others.

God doesn't just erase your brokenness, He redeems it
