Giving Back


We believe that giving is an act of worship in response to God's Love for us. If you are "checking us out", we just ask that you sit back and receive.

1 Peter 2:9-10

Gospel Applied

The first application of every sermon and study we will ever do is simply this: BELIEVE.

1) Believe that:

We are more sinful that we dare face; More Loved that we could ever dream: More Instrumental than we could imagine.

- 2) To learn what you TRULY believe, look at what you do and don't do. Your goals, values, anxieties, relationship, schedule etc.
 - 3) In your ups and downs, grow in Dependence and Worship.
