Excerpts from the Resolutions of Jonathan Edwards (early 1700's)

- 1. Resolved, that I will do whatsoever I think to be most to God's glory, and my own good, profit and pleasure, in the whole of my duration, without any consideration of the time. Resolved to do whatever I think to be my duty and most for the good and advantage of mankind in general. Resolved to do this, whatever difficulties I meet with, how many and how great soever.
- 3. Resolved, if ever I shall neglect to keep any part of these Resolutions, to repent of all I can remember, when I come to myself again.
 - 6. Resolved, to live with all my might, while I do live.



- 8. Resolved, to act, in all respects, both speaking and doing, as if nobody had been so vile as I, and as if I had committed the same sins, or had the same infirmities or failings as others; and that I will let the knowledge of their failings promote nothing but shame in myself, and prove only an occasion of my confessing my own sins and misery to God.
 - 14. Resolved, never to do anything out of revenge.
 - 16. Resolved, never to speak evil of anyone.
 - 25. Resolved, to examine carefully, and constantly, what that one thing in me is, which causes me in the least to doubt of the love of God; and to direct all my forces against it.
 - 43. Resolved, never henceforward, till I die, to act as if I were any way my own, but entirely and altogether God's, agreeable to what is to be found in Scripture.
