When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, ¹⁷ got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum.

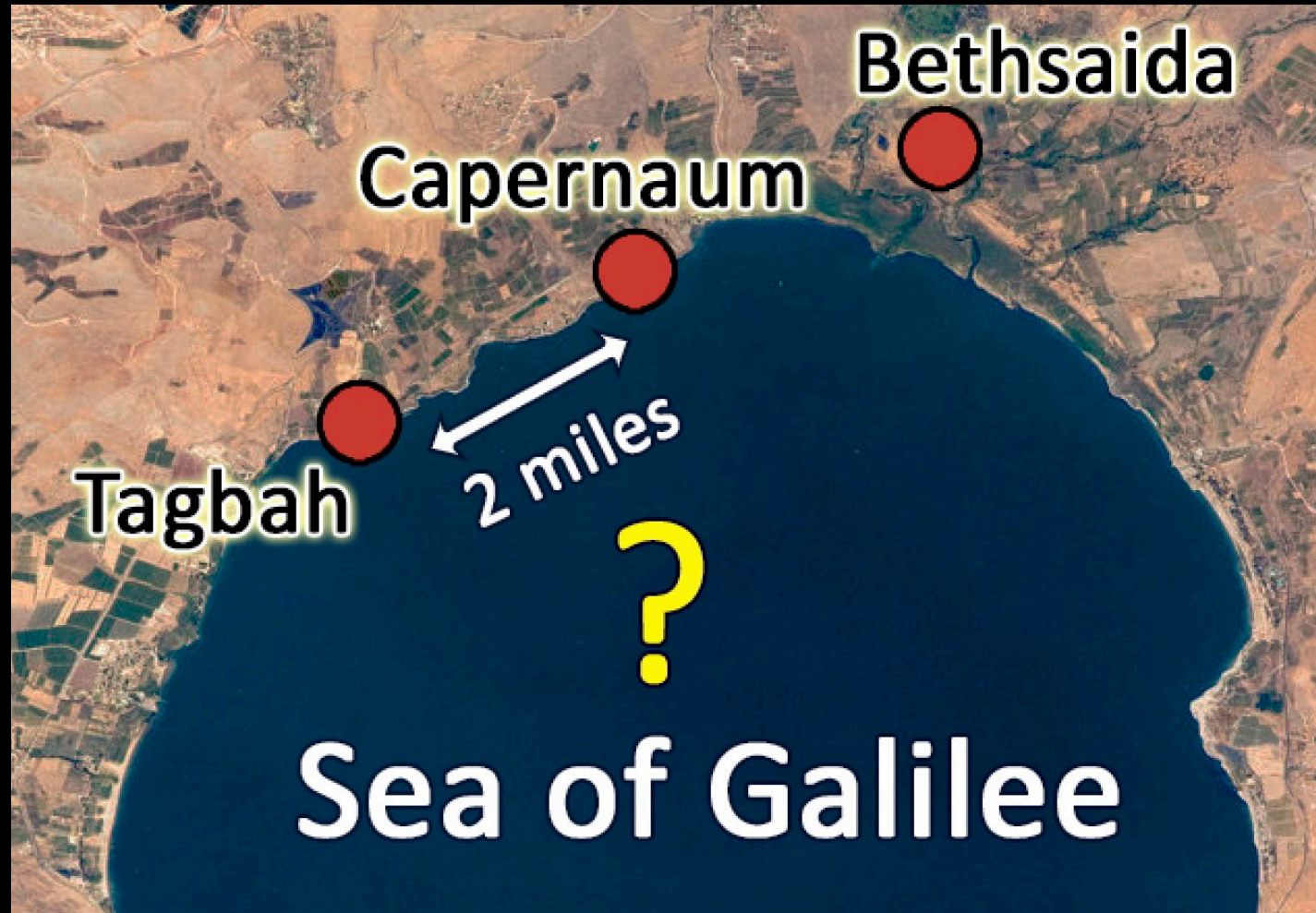
