The Lie of Presumption : My Control

Proverbs 27:1 Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring. ^{14b} What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes.

Luke 12:15 And he said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶ As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.

How Can I KNOW God's Will?

Westminster Catechism (1647): Question #1 – What is our chief end? Answer – To glorify God and enjoy him forever ¹⁷ So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, *for him* it is sin.
