James 5:13-18

Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise. ¹⁴ Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.



¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. No Prayer

Weak Prayer

God has the ability, but I don't think he cares about me or my problems.

Weak Prayer

God loves me, but I don't think he personally helps in real life.

Faith Prayer

God is my loving Daddy who has the ability and desire to do what is best for me.

"Prayer of faith"

Humble:

In absolute dependence, admitting my weakness.

Specific:

Pleading for exactly what is on our hearts.

"...But if you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." ²³ And Jesus said to him, "'If you can'! All things are possible for one who believes." ²⁴ Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!"

VERYDAY FAITH

Prayer is God passionately inviting us to sit down and spend intimate time and conversation with him; to hear His sweet words and get to know His heart; to listen to him reveal Truth to us.

VERYDAY FAITH

Matthew 7:8-11

For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. ⁹ Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰ Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? ¹¹ If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!



Matthew 26:36-46

Then Jesus went with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here, while I go over there and pray." ³⁷ And taking with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, he began to be sorrowful and troubled. ³⁸ Then he said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with me." ³⁹ And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."
