# Designed In and For Intimacy

Genesis 2:24-25

#### Matthew 5:27

<sup>18</sup> Let your *fountain be blessed*, and *rejoice* in the wife of your youth, <sup>19</sup> a lovely deer, a graceful doe.

God doesn't want less for us, he wants **MORE**.

Fully Enjoy the "Fire" ...often.

From Jason and the Argonauts (third century BC): When Orpheus heard the voice of the sirens, he drew out his lyre and played his music *more beautifully* than they, drowning out their voices.

It's a tiny preview of True Intimacy.

# Gospel Intimacy

#### Hosea 2

- <sup>1</sup> "Therefore, behold, I will *allure* her, and bring her into the wilderness, and speak tenderly to her."
- <sup>19</sup> And I will betroth you to me forever. I will betroth you to me in righteousness and in justice, in **steadfast love** and in **mercy** (vs. to the "merciless" in v.9). <sup>20</sup> I will **betroth** you to me in **faithfulness**. And you shall **know** the LORD.

#### **Revelation 21**

<sup>1</sup>Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

<sup>9</sup> Then came one of the seven angels..."Come, I will show you the Bride, the wife of the Lamb."...11 having the glory of God, its radiance like a most rare jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

#### Rev 22:17

The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.
