Jeremiah 17:9-10 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it? <sup>10</sup> "I the Lord search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds." Genesis 6:5-6 The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. <sup>6</sup> And the LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart. Our Broken Hearts: What it looks like

The problem isn't our behavior, it's our hearts, our loves, which is revealed in our behavior.

#### Our Broken Hearts: What it causes

<sup>12:25</sup> Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad.  <sup>28:14</sup> Blessed is the one who fears the LORD always,
 but whoever hardens his heart will fall into calamity.

Do you ever feel heavy, alone, hopeless and helpless... Like you can't get things right... Like your faith will never be strong enough... Like you are a disappointment?

#### The Hope for a New Hearts

#### We can't fix ourselves

<sup>20:9</sup> Who can say, "I have made my heart pure; I am clean from my sin"?

#### **But God offers us a New Heart**

<sup>16:9</sup> The heart of man plans his way, but the LORD establishes his steps.

Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

#### The Gift of a New Hearts

Psalm 51 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. <sup>11</sup> Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. <sup>17</sup> The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Jesus simply asks us to own the brokenness of our hearts and bring them to him.

On the cross his heart was broken on our behalf so that we could have his heart from this day on. The Result of a New Hearts
