






Who Was Smyrna

- "Smyrna" means myrrh (perfume)
- Very large harbor town
- First to have "Cult to Rome" (Roma)
- "Most faithful ally" to Rome
- Synagogue was Tax Exempt

The Filter

2 Corinthians 4

¹⁶ So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, ¹⁸ as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen.
