What I "owe" you What you "owe" me

1) Grace and Mercy Ride In

Palm Sunday, when Jesus rides into Jerusalem to great fanfare only to later be abused and abandoned on a cross, from which he showers forgiveness (mercy) and love (grace) on the very ones that put him there.

2) Grace and Mercy Rise Up

Easter Sunday, when Jesus rises up from the grave, defeating sin and death as he fully pays our debts (mercy) and gives us his life (grace), which pushed us outward to love the way we've been loved.

Matthew 5:43-48

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? 47 And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? 48 You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

The Ambiguous "They"

We stereotype and demonize ("hate") many who disagree with us. Some for petty reasons, some for significant reasons.

NYT - OpEd Arthur C. Brooks

Political scientists have found that our nation is more polarized than it has been at any time since the Civil War... (coming from) the assumption that your ideology is based in love, while your opponent's is based in hate.

People often say that our problem in America today is incivility or intolerance. This is incorrect. (It is) something far worse: contempt, which is a noxious brew of anger and disgust. And not just contempt for other people's ideas, but also for other people.

This is a chance to change at least one heart—yours. Respond with warmheartedness and good humor. You are guaranteed to be happier. If that also affects the contemptuous person (or bystanders), it will be to the good.

The Specific him or her

We have all been painfully wronged and may rightfully "hate" somebody for what they have done to us.

⁴⁴ But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven.

Jesus is asking for the absolutely impossible, even ridiculous and seemingly inappropriate.

I can't "love" that person ... those people!
