Thanksgiving:


Praising God for What He done

The need under the need:

What we truly want is not the things itself, but wholeness, fulfillment, satisfaction...heaven.

And actually, what our hearts truly want...is HIM.





Matthew 9:20-22

And behold, a woman who had suffered from a discharge of blood for twelve years came up behind him and touched the fringe of his garment, ²¹ for she said to herself, "If I only touch his garment, I will be made well." ²² Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, "Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well." And instantly ("permanently") the woman was made well.

I cannot get up and give you anything'? 8 I tell you, though he will not get up and give him anything because he is his friend, yet because of his impudence (persistence) he will rise and give him whatever he needs.



How we can be sure God's answers are Good


Matthew 26:38
