





Realize and confess that I perpetually build my life on the wrong foundation

6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Pursue and rest in Jesus' righteousness rather than my own

5:20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.

Begin to live heavenward not in order to be loved and find fulfillment but because you are, and have.

On the Cross the full force of God's Holy Storm fell on Jesus...on our behalf, he succumbed to it and "great was the fall of it."

BUT, in rising from the dead, he now sits enthroned and calls us to build our lives upon Him, The Cornerstone.

Matthew 16:15

(Jesus) said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"

¹⁶ Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

¹⁷ And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. ¹⁸ And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

What do we do with what this?

“I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: I’m ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don’t accept his claim to be God. That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic — on the level with the man who says he is a poached egg — or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse. You can shut him up for a fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God, but let us not come with any patronizing nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to.”
